Plywood	1	190x120x4	Base Plate	1
Wooden Strips	2	250x20x10	Frame	2
Wooden Strips	1	150x40x10	Support	3
Clothes Peg	2	70	Note Holder	4



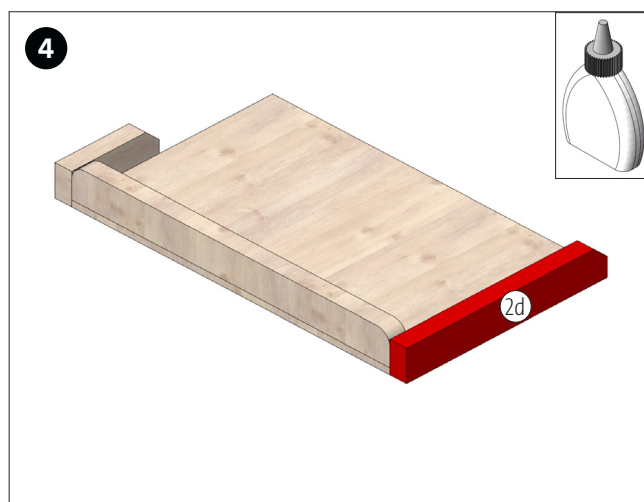
Cut the two wooden strips (2) according to the dimensions (see page 3) and clean the saw cuts. Round off the corners of the strip (2a) with the file.



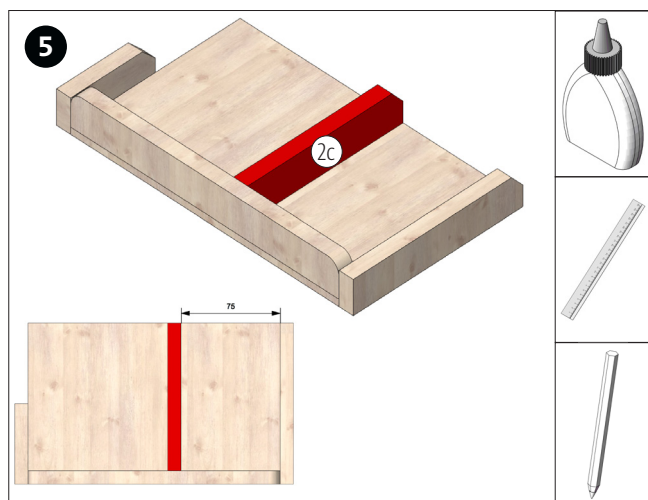
Glue the strip (2a) onto the base plate (1) flush with the outer edge. Let the glue dry well.



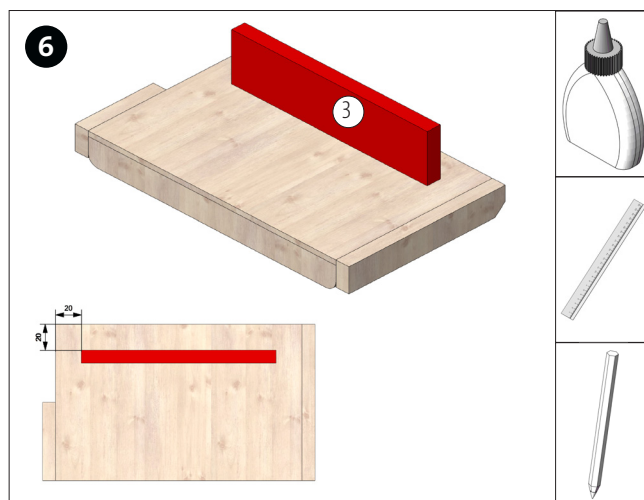
Glue the strip (2b) on the left outer side flush with the bottom edge. Let the glue dry well.



Glue the strip (2d) on the right outer side flush with the bottom edge. Let the glue dry well.

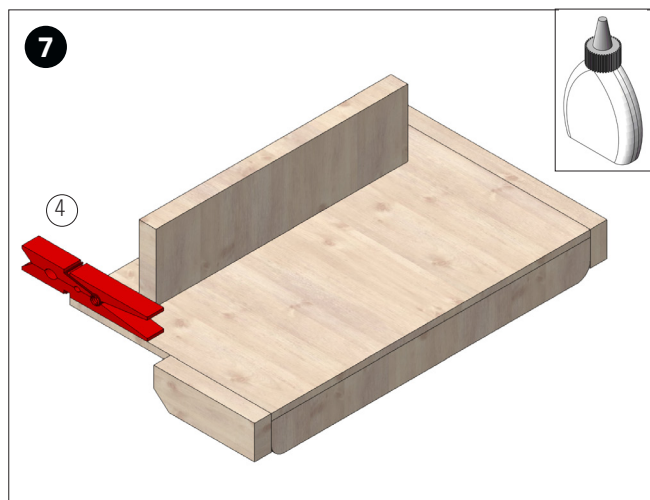


Glue the strip (2c) according to the dimensions shown, at a distance of 75 mm from the strip (2d). Let the glue dry well.

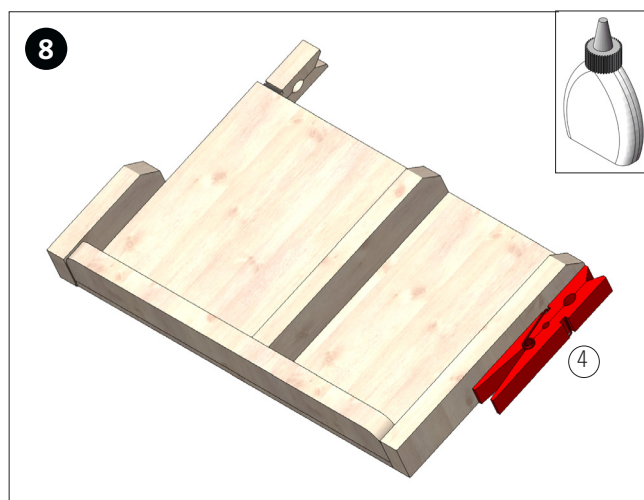


Glue the wooden strip (3) on the back according to the dimensions. Let the glue dry well.

Glue a clothes peg (4) as a note holder to the back so that it shows approx. 20 mm upwards (see picture!)



Glue the second clothes peg (4) to the right strip (2d) flush with the top edge as a pen holder. (See picture!)
