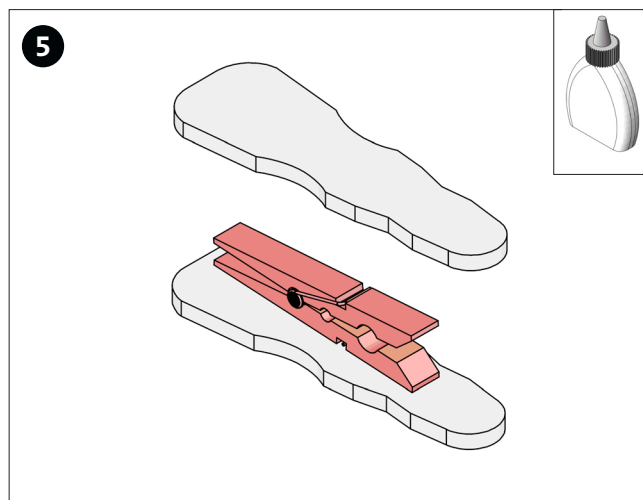
Transfer your selected template to the plywood (1).  
**Note: In the following steps the construction of the crocodile is described. The construction of the other motifs is identical!**



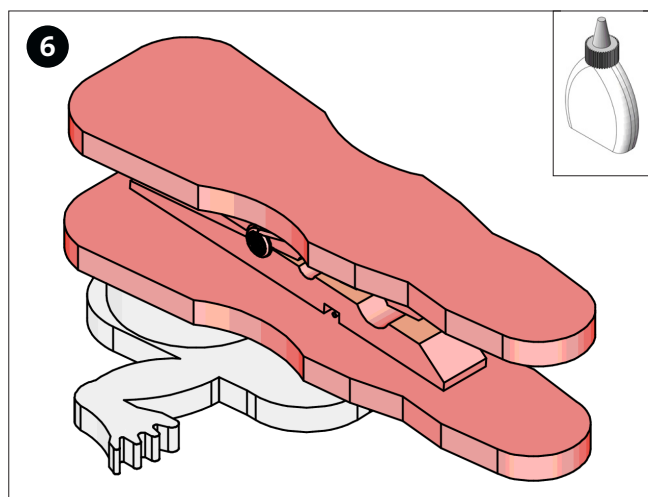
Saw out and sand the parts.



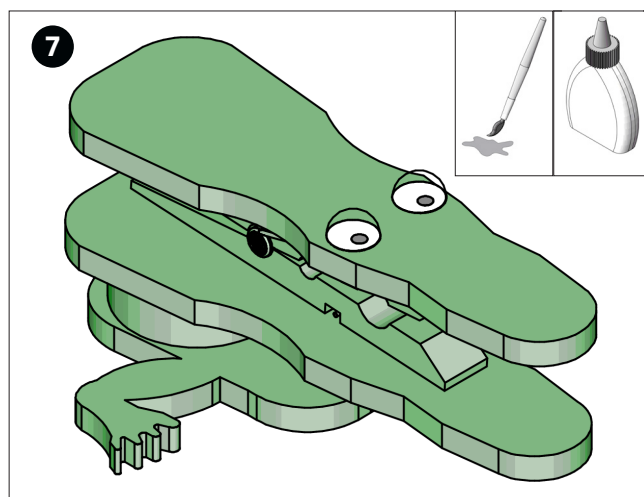
Glue the lower part to the wooden wheel (2).



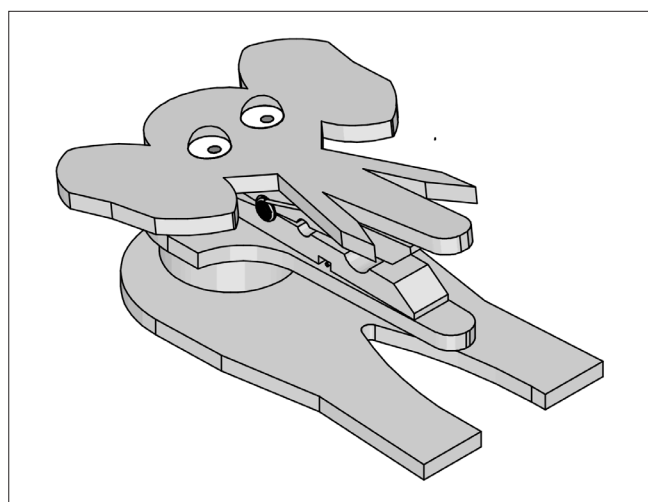
Glue the middle and upper part congruently to the wooden clamp (3).



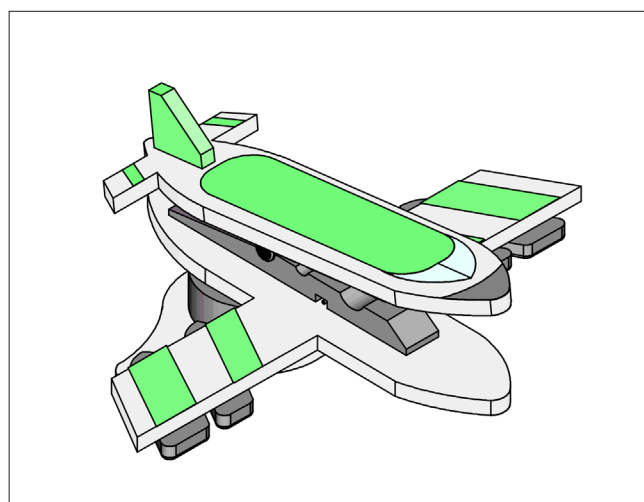
Glue both parts together. (middle-/upper part on the wooden wheel)



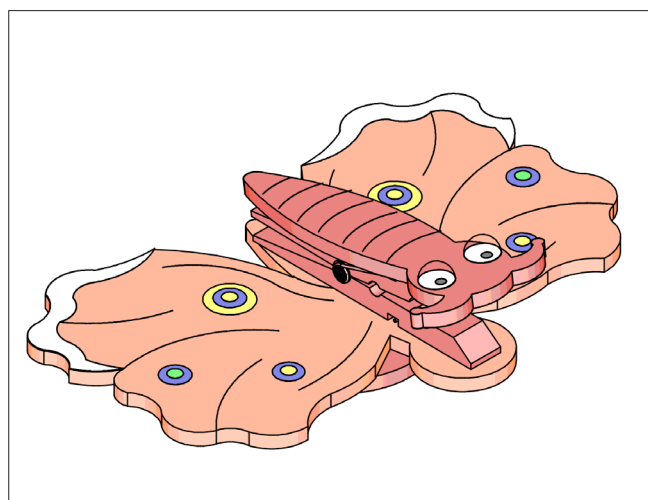
After the glue has dried, the noteholder can be coloured according to your imagination and the eyes can be glued on.

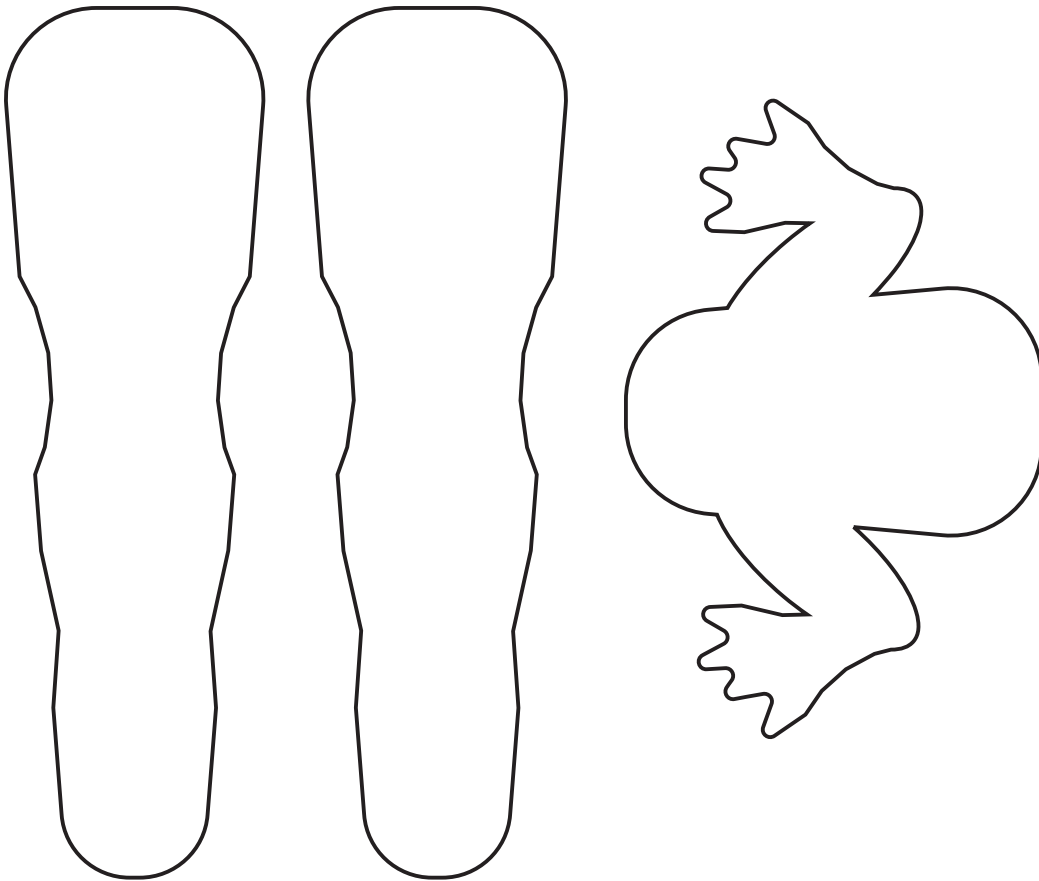

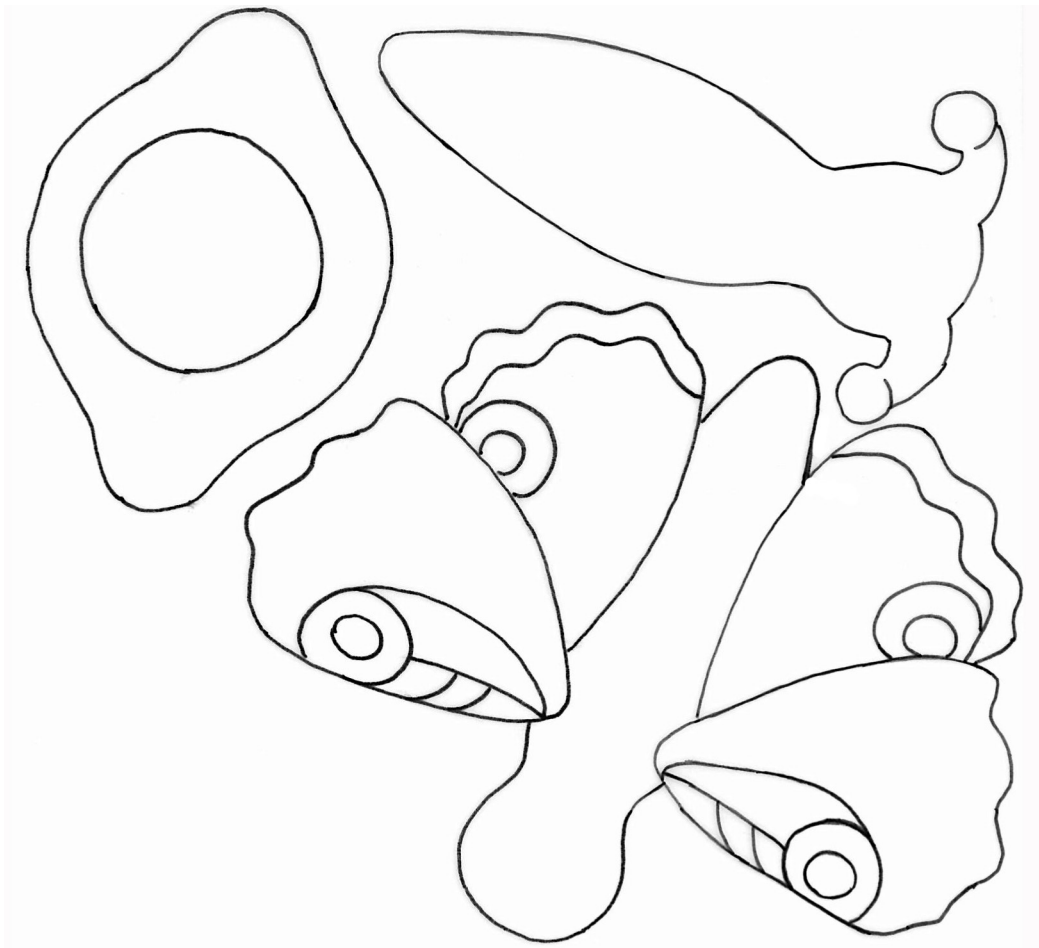

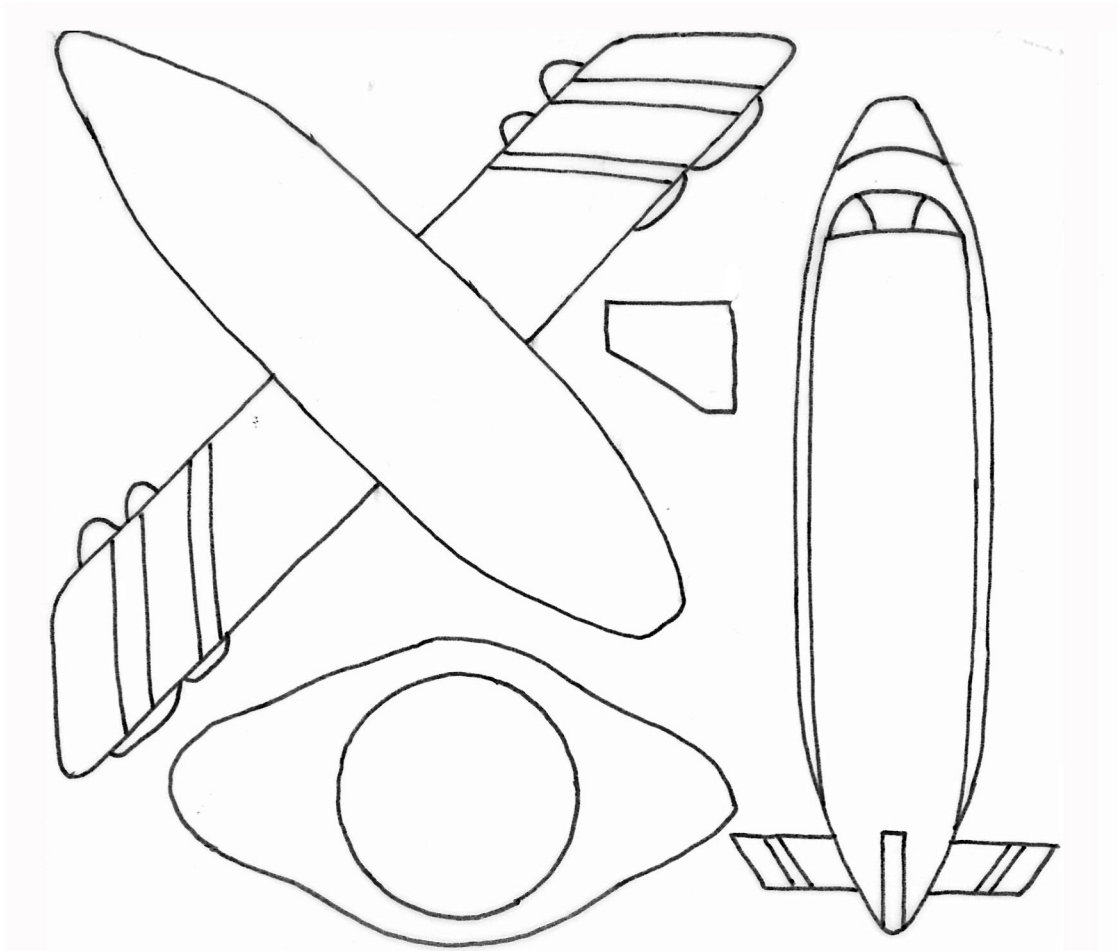
