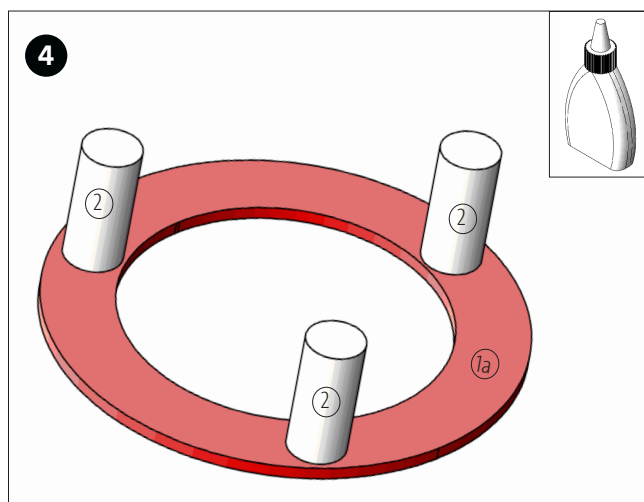
Cut the template. (Page 5).



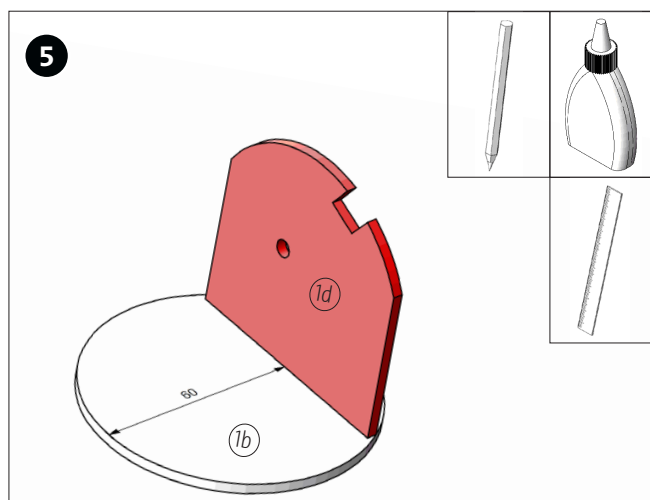
Fix the former plate on the base (1) and cut the individual parts (1a – 1g) with the jigsaw. Clean the saw cuts with sandpaper. Drill the $\varnothing 5$ mm hole



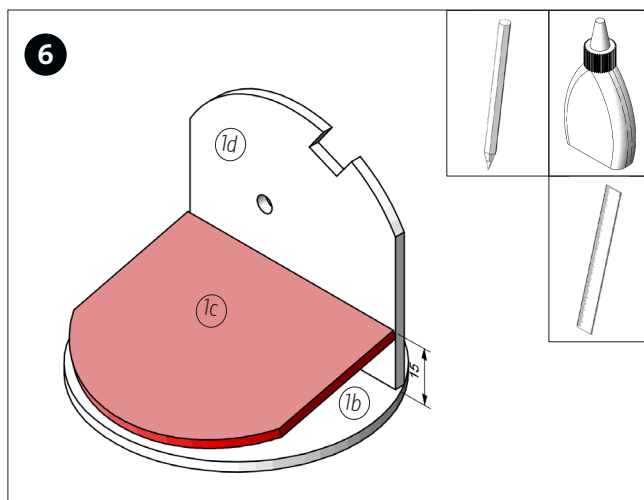
Measure and mark each 30 mm on the rod (2) as shown. Then cut the lines with the jigsaw and clean the saw cuts with sandpaper..



Glue the 30 mm long pieces (2) to the shaded points of the wooden ring (1a). Let it dry well.

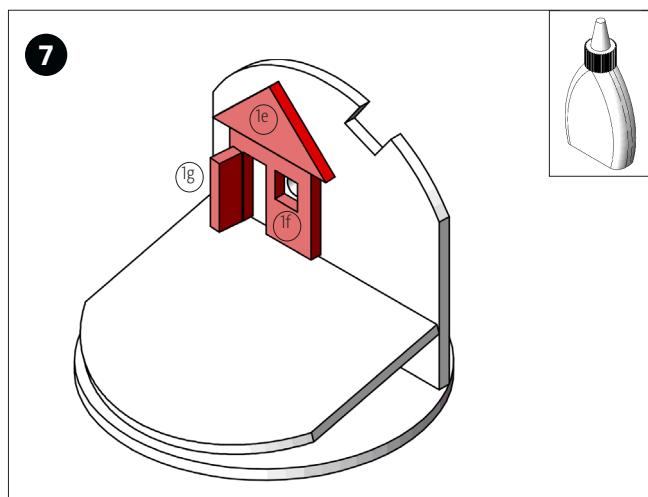


Measure and mark 60 mm on part (1b). In addition glue part (1d) vertical to the marked line as shown and let it dry well.

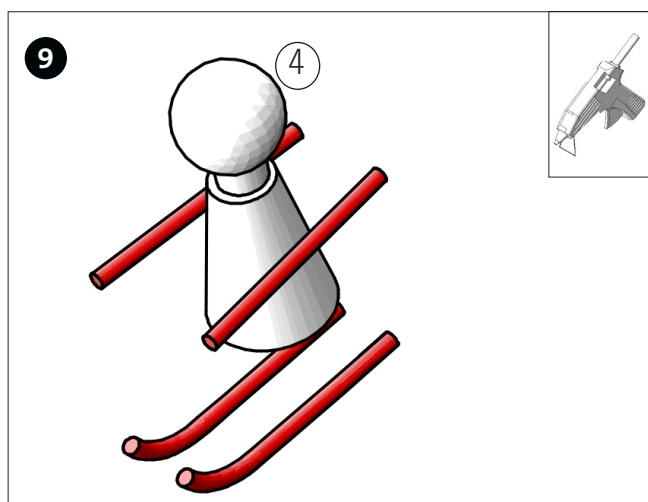


Measure and mark from the bottom edge of part (1d) 15mm. Now glue the footwall cut-off of part (1c) to part (1d) as shown. Glue the leading edge to part (1b), so that part (1c) is diagonal.

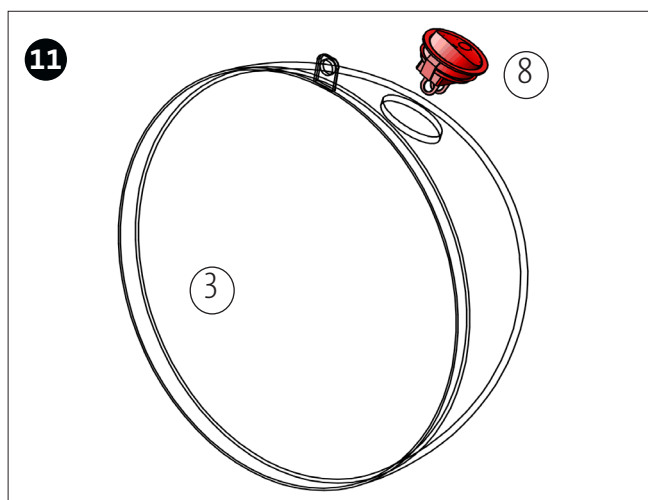

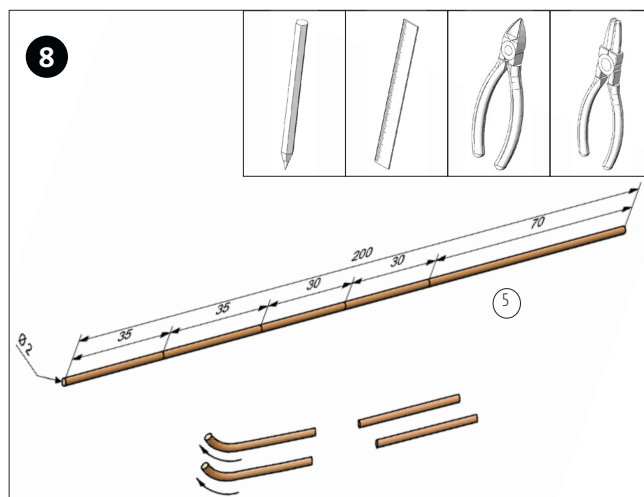
Glue the wooden parts (1e–1g) to the backwall (1d) as shown. Look to it that, the window opening binds the drill (ø5mm). Glue the door (1g) vertical to part (1f). Add colour at will.



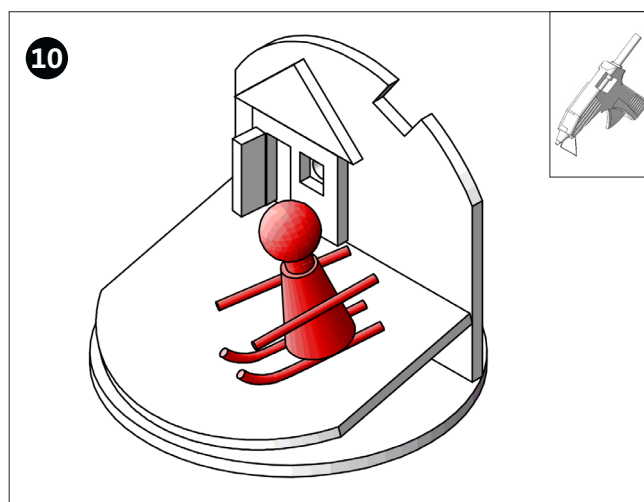
the wire parts with the hot glue gun to the wooden figure (4). Then colour it at will.



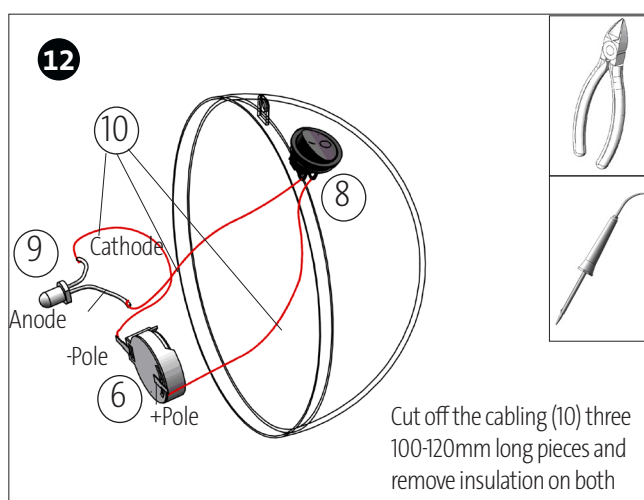

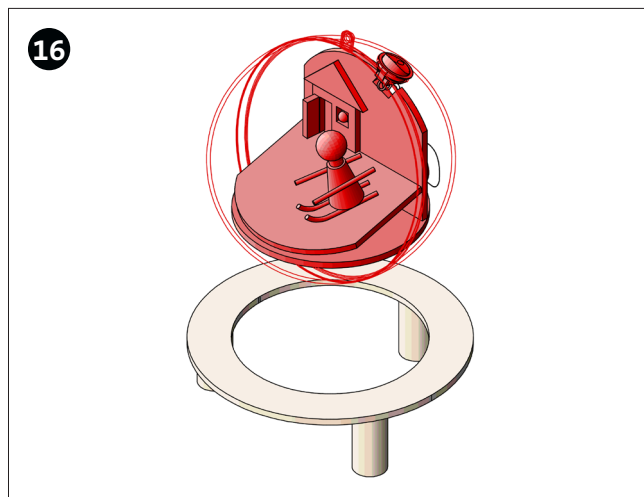
Attach the battery holder with hot glue to the backside of the back wall (1d) as shown. Put the LED into the drilling. Furthermore put the button cell (7) in the battery holder and check functioning.



Colour the landscape at will and let it dry well. Then put the landscape in the acrylic ball.



Last clip on the second ball half.



Place the finished ball on the support. Alternatively thread a string through the eyelet and hang up the ball. Done!
