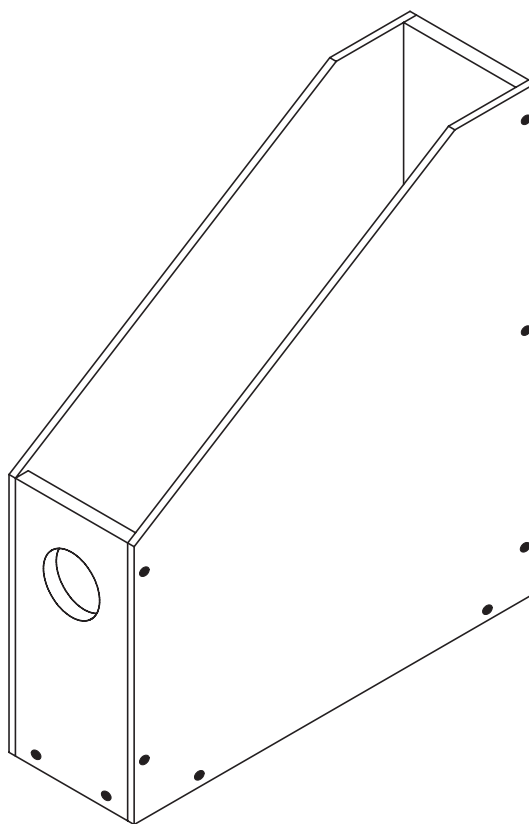

## A 4 - Magazine holder



#### Necessary tools & equipment:

Fretsaw and board  
Wood file, glass paper  
Hand drill or pillar drill  
Bradawl, Forstner bit 35mm diameter  
Wood glue  
Paints

#### Parts list:

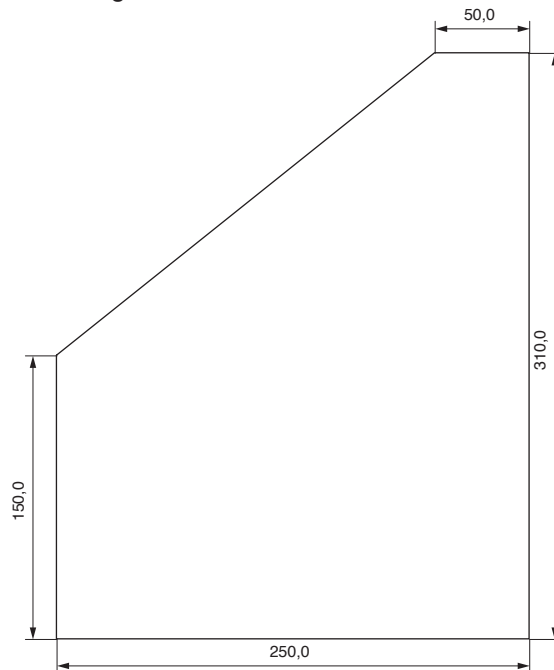
1x	Pine plywood	8 x 70 x 150 mm
2x	Pine plywood	8 x 70 x 310 mm
2x	Pine plywood	4 x 250 x 310 mm
18x	panel pins	20 mm

#### Please Note

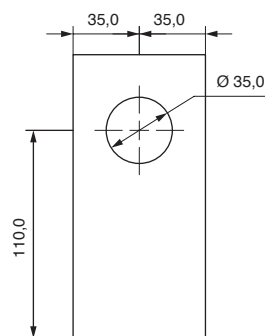
The OPITEC range of projects is not intended as play toys for young children. They are teaching aids for young people learning the skills of Craft, Design and Technology. These projects should only be undertaken and tested with the guidance of a fully qualified adult. The finished projects are not suitable to give to children under 3 years old. Some parts can be swallowed. Danger of suffocation!

### Instructions:

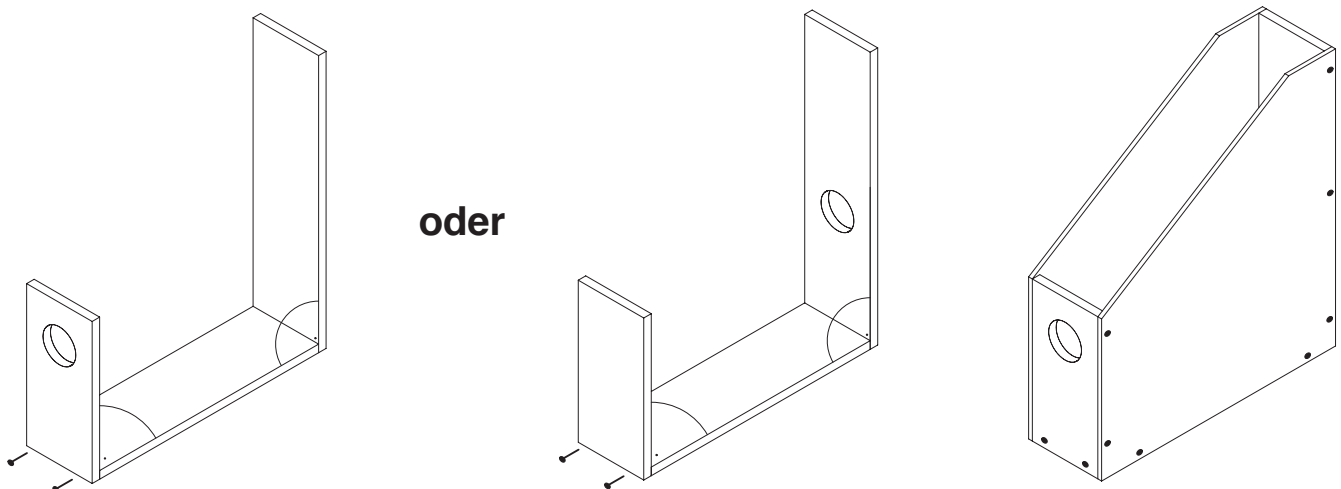
1. Mark out the shape of the sides on to the plywood sheets 4 x 250 x 275mm  
Saw out and sand all the sawn edges.



2. Drill a 35mm diameter hole ( Use a Forstner bit or Fret saw ) in the front 8 x 70 x 150mm or rear frame panel 8 x 70 x 310mm.



3. For the base saw a plywood strip 8 x 70 x 310mm to 8 x 70 x 234mm. Sand the edges.



4. Assemble wood parts, glue and nail ( 4 nails ) the bottom and ends as shown.
5. Apply glue to one side of the frame, add one side panel and adjust to fit as necessary Use the panel pins to hold it in place. Once you are satisfied add the remaining side panel in the same way.
6. Place you're A4 Magazine file to one side and allow the glue to dry.  
Finally decorate and finish with a coat of clear varnish or use wax.
