
Mark out the measurements on the pine strip 250x20x20 mm (Part 1). Saw and out the joints with a chisel as shown Round off the ends of the stand

Round off the ends of the pine strip 125x20x20 mm (Part 2). Sand parts 1 and 2 to finish


Glue the feet (Part 2) into the slots cut out in the stand (Part 1) (See diagram)


Measure and mark out the middle of the wooden discs (Part 3) (Use a centre finding tool)

Use a pair of pliers to remove the tabs from the tealight holders.
