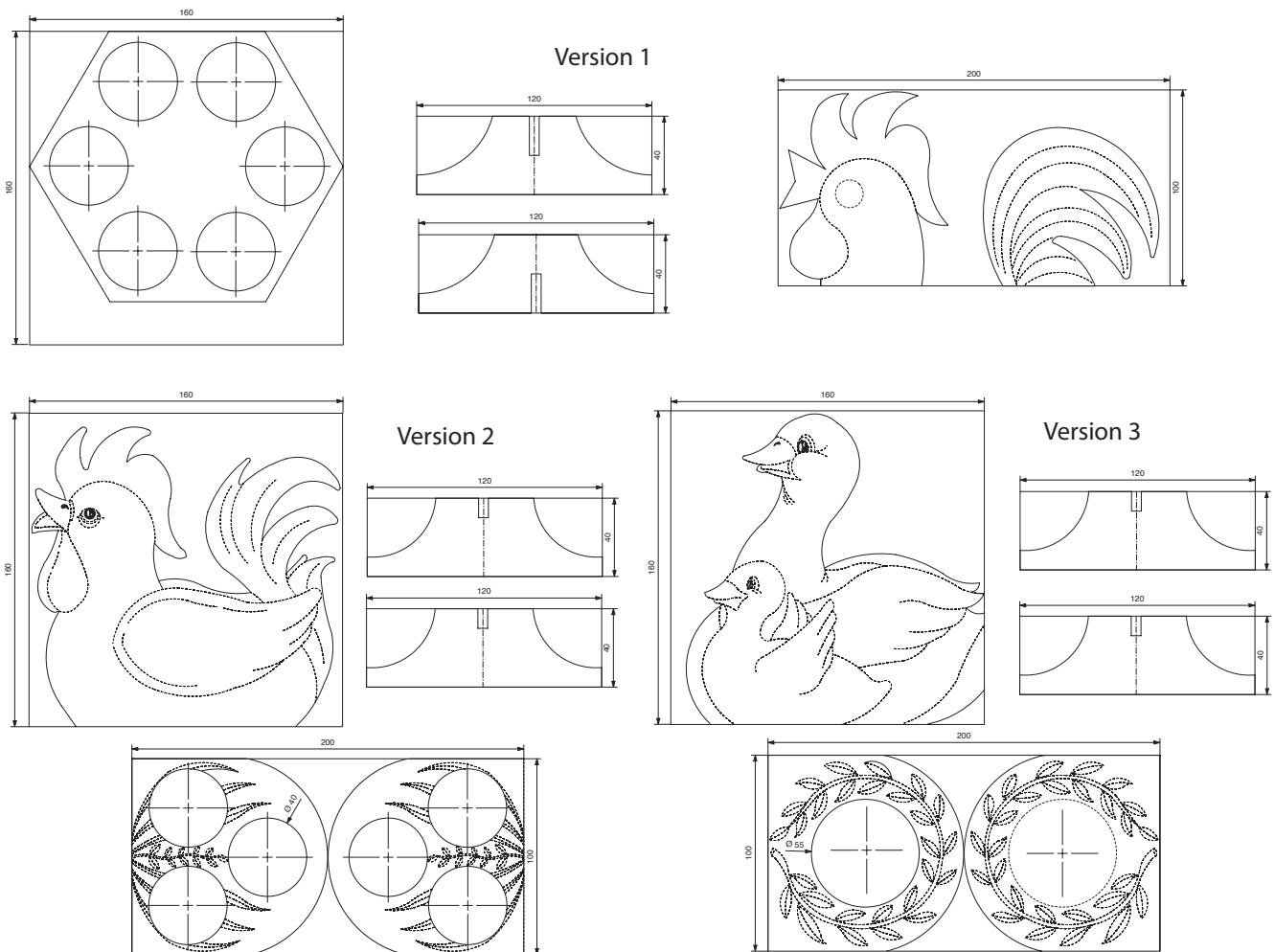
INSTRUCTIONS

General:

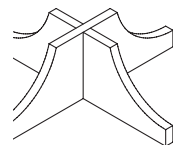
Using this craft pack you can make 3 different variations. The pattern that you will need are included in the following pages. The instructions describe making designs 1 and 2. Designs 3 and 4 are made in the same way!

1. Use tracing paper to transfer the patterns (Scale 1:1) on to the corresponding plywood sheet. Saw out all the parts that are shown with continuous line. The broken lines serve as a guide to painting. sand all the sawn edges

The egg / flower holes are made as follows. Drill a small hole in the middle of the larger hole, remove the fretsaw blade and pass it through the wood. Re-insert the the blade in the saw frame and cut out the larger holes etc. Finally sand all the sawn edges



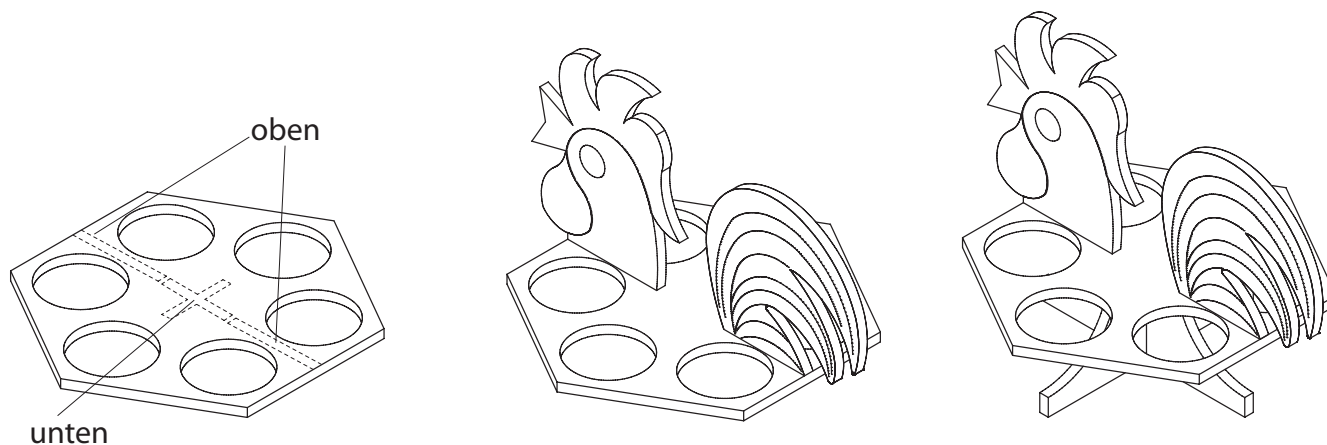
2. The socket (Version 1) and feet (Version 2+3) are both cut out of the plywood sheet (3). Afterwards the parts must be adjusted in shape so that they fit together (version 2+3)



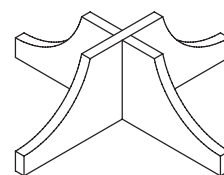
3. Once all the parts have been sawn they can be sanded and painted (Acrylic or poster paint). The broken lines will help you to decorate the finished work decoratively.

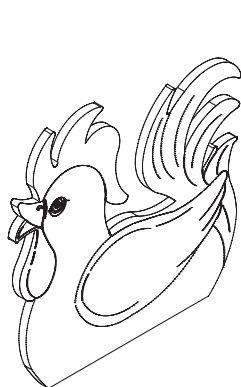

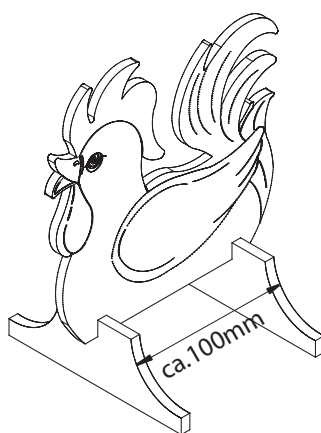
4. Die Klebestellen für Kopf und Gefieder an der Eierblage anzeichnen und dann aufleimen.

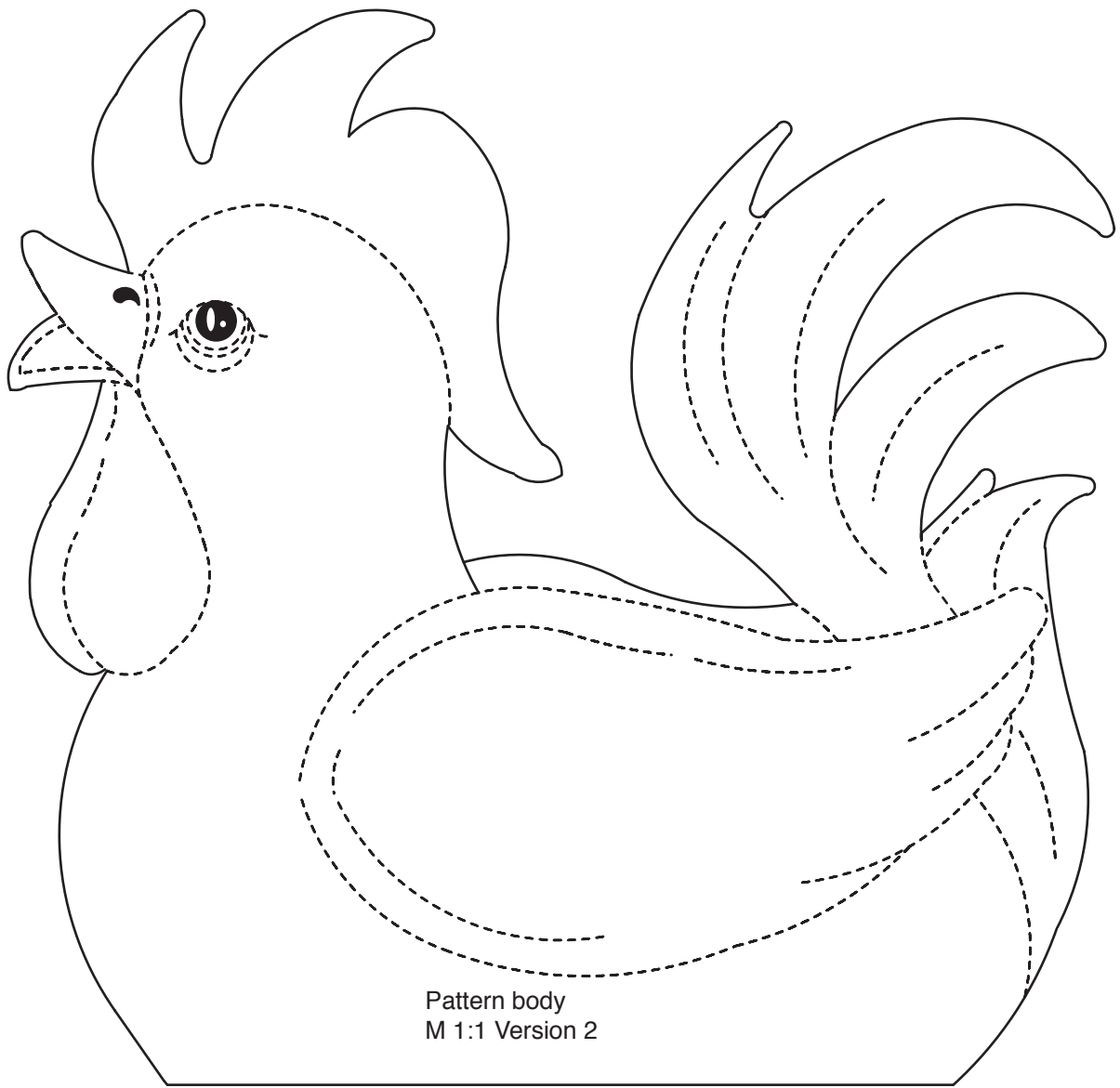


7. Die Füße wie abgebildet an der Unterkante aufstecken und festleimen.



8. Die Ablagen beidseitig auf die Füße aufleimen! Leim gut trocknen lassen.

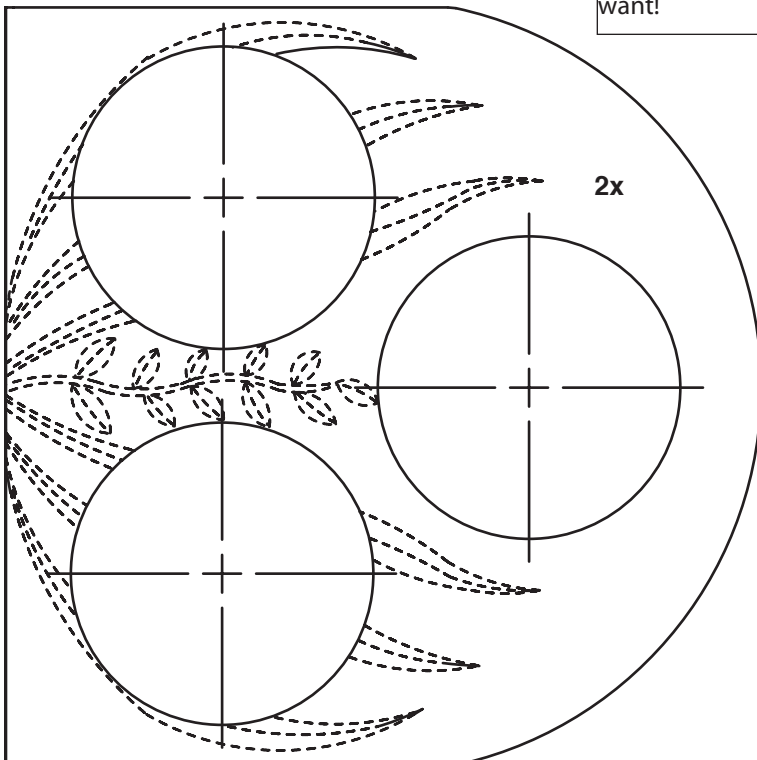

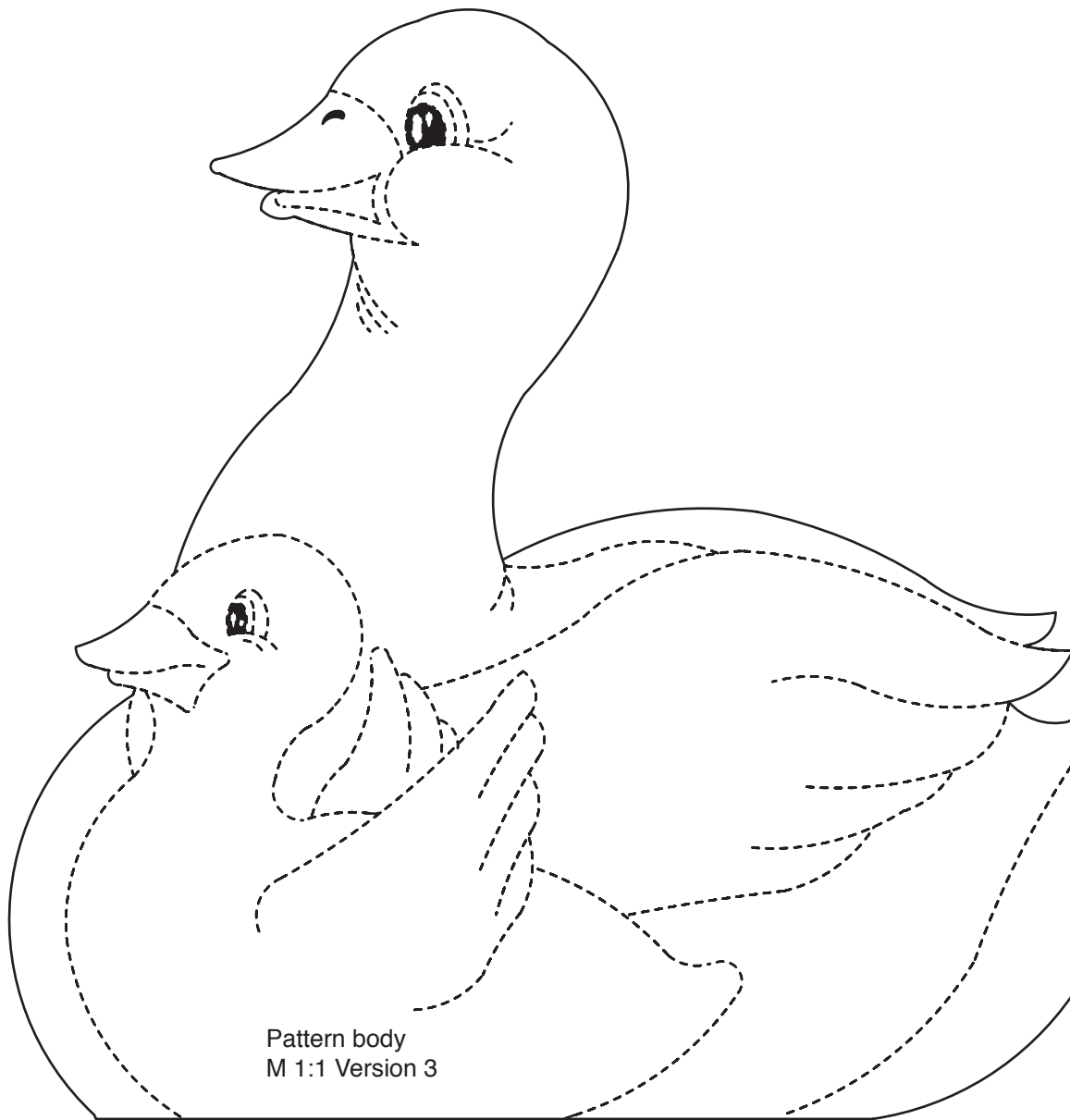

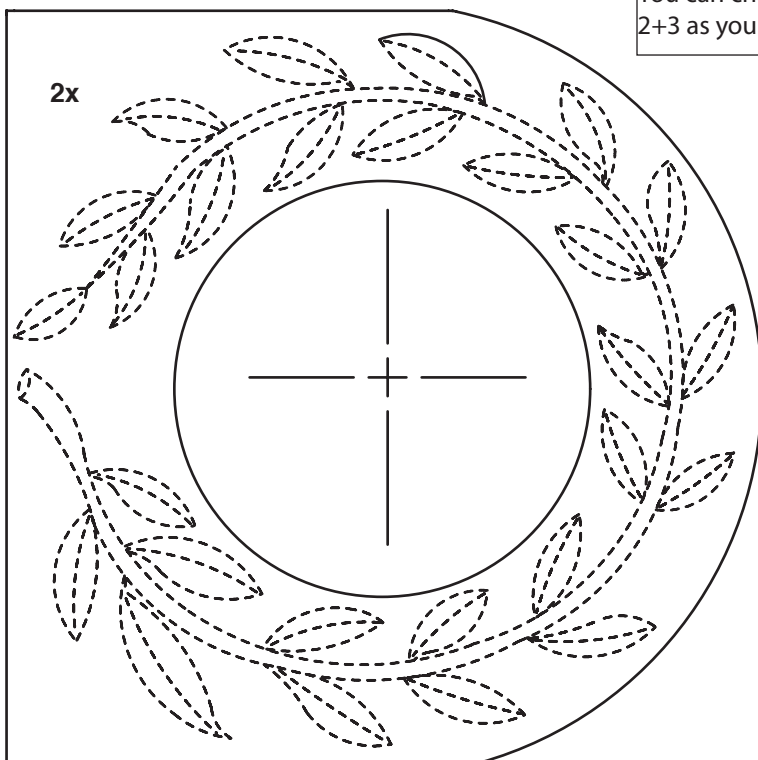
