AUTOSOL® Cleaner for Agricultural Machinery - *acidic* -

Cleaning concentrate based on inorganic acids and surfactants for the removal of stubborn mineral dirt on agricultural machinery.

Fields for application

For the cleaning of agriculture machinery, spraying equipment, tubs, agitators, filters, etc.

Properties

- Removes easily mineral dirt, cement, lime and also rust and corrosion
- Very efficient and cost effective
- Save on glass surfaces
- Compliant to REGULATION (EC) No 648/2004 of 31 March 2004 on detergents

Application

Depending on the grade of contamination dilute product 1:20 to 1:1 with water. Attention: Pour the cleaner into the water and NOT the other way around! Spray cleaner solution evenly onto the surfaces to be cleaned from a distance of one metre. Allow to take effect for 10 to 30 minutes. Thoroughly rinse the vehicle with a strong water jet using plenty of water at a distance of 1 m. In case of extremely stubborn dirt repeat the application.

Note

Test material compatibility prior to use on an inconspicuous area. Do not allow cleaner to dry. Do not use on hot surfaces or under direct sun.
